## Format

- a) This event is bowled over 3 days commencing on Friday 29h May 2020 and culminating on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020.
- b) This event is open to all bowling centres throughout Queensland.
- c) Each centre can submit up to 6 teams of 5 players (or part thereof). Your centre and or players don't have to compete all 3 days
- d) Your \$20 non-refundable deposit secures your teams sport in this event.
- e) Should a centre be unable to field full teams of 5, bowlers from other centres can help fill their spaces if available. Their scores shall go towards the centre they are play with.
- f) Teams are required to have a minimum of 4 players in a team. The vacancy scores are not added to the individual team scores.
- g) Sub's are permitted to bowl in a bowler's place if the team member is sick or injured. If injured or sick during a game a blind score will be entered to complete the game.
- h) It is requested that a list of bowlers and their highest current average be emailed to the tournament committee (donna.lyne72@yahoo.com) by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2020. The averages are to be the highest league average over a minimum of 12 games as at 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020. If a bower does not a have an established average prior to the event they will need to apply to the tournament committee to determine an appropriate average to be used. When the list is supplied please state who verified the average.
- i) All bowlers must be aged over 50 years of age by 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020.
- j) The winning centre is decided by the highest handicap average over the 3 days.
- k) The handicap used will be 100% of 200 and in the overall calculations the vacancy and blind scores will not be added.
- March Past All available players are requested to join in the march with their team.
  All players are requested to be in team uniform.
- m) Team photos will be taken after the march pass and will be emailed to your centre.
  Other photos taken through the weekend activities will also be emailed to your centre.
